Teaching Space Renovation Proposal

The College of Arts, Sciences, and Business recognizes that some teaching spaces on campus no longer meet the basic needs of instructors and students. Although structural renovations may not be feasible, even relatively minor improvements (new desks or tables/chairs, fresh paint, new whiteboards or chalkboards, new carpet) can significantly improve the experience of teaching and learning within these spaces. To this end, the College of Arts, Sciences, and Business invites proposals from department chairs to renovate existing teaching spaces commonly used by their faculty and students. Although CASB does not have a separate budget line to cover these improvements, the Dean will advocate for these changes with Physical Facilities and the Office of Finance and Administration.
